


THE SPAWN FROM HELL

Those of you that may have read the now out-of-print book or comics of B. Banzai know of The Spawn of Hell, Hanoi Han. From the works of H. Ashton Wolfe and Philip Jose' Farmer, we have pieced together a probable background on Han.


Hanoi Han appears to have been born in 1840 to Sir William Clayton and Ling Ju Hai.* Han was originally a good natured governor of Ton Kin, China. Then, in a nearly fatal accident, he was smashed against a tree while supervising an elephant roundup. After nearly dying in a Saigon hospital, where he was being treated, he left for Paris in hopes that his severly twisted spine could be repaired. But these efforts were futile, the damage could not be repaired. Thus, Han grew bitter and evil.

While Han was in Paris he begin his own underround network of criminals. In 1906 his men carried out deemingly impossible thefts and murders. The police soon traced the crimes back to Han, whom they called L'Araignee (french for spider).

Soon after Han fell into obscurity. For twelve years he laid low studying medicine. Then he finally found a surgeon in London who could assist in repairing his twisted body. After his successful surgery he returned to the East, where he began rumors of his death. Whether he actually lives, or passed his legacy onto a son, still remains a mystery.

There are rumors that Han invented an elixer called the Oil of Life which slowed down his aging process. The modern day Han, just like the one of the 1800's is over six feet tall, and has dark hair and green eyes.

Hanoi Kan in his fortess at Sabah, Malya, continues to wage war against the forces of good.*2 However Team Banzai continues their struggles to defeat Han and his evil minions, and the infamous World Crime League.

We will meet afterwards at Daily's restraunt in Fremont on the corner of Mowry Ave. and Blakow Rd. about 10:00pm.


